What's it like working in Water?

With EVC's program you learn about waste water and drinking water. The Water Technology program prepares students for entering the water industry and prepares them for certification exams.

LAB WORK

Hands-on work in water or wastewater laboratories to monitor the treatment process.

COMPLIANCE WORK

As an Environmental Compliance inspector identify and prevent current and potential sources of pollution.

MAINTENANCE

Inspect, clean, maintain, construct, and repair systems like: sanitary sewers, storm drains, pump stations, pipes, manholes and catch basins.

OPERATIONS

As treatment and distribution operators removing pollutants and contaminants from wastewater and manage the safe transport and disposal of treated wastewater.

ENGINEERING

Assesses the environmental impact of infrastructure projects, such as capital planning, to become an environmental engineer.
