San José - Evergreen Community College District Parking Permits Frequently Asked Questions Regarding Student Permits

- 1. Are students required to purchase parking permits for the upcoming Academic Year? Yes. Students are required to purchase parking permits for the fall, spring and summer semester. Winter intersession parking is waived.
- 2. Will student parking permits be virtual or a physical decal? Parking permits will only be virtual.
- 3. How long are student parking permits valid for?

 Student parking permits are good for only one semester. Students will be required to purchase parking permits every semester they are enrolled (excluding winter).

purchase parking permits every semester they are enrolled (excluding winter intersession.)

4. Are students able to purchase daily parking permits?

Yes. Students may purchase daily parking permits for \$3.00. (Please see Appendix)

5. May a student register more than one vehicle, per permit?

Yes. Two vehicles may be registered with the initial parking permit request. A third vehicle may be registered by emailing support@getapermit.net. A student may register a maximum of up to (3) vehicles.

- 6. Is there a cost for student parking permits?
 - Yes. Student parking permits cost \$45 for students without the California College Promise Grant, \$25 for students with the California College Promise Grant, and \$15 for students who operate motorcycles.
- 7. Are student parking permits required at the San José City College Milpitas Extension? No. Students solely taking courses at the San José City College Milpitas Extension re not required to purchase parking permits.
- 8. How may a student order a parking permit without a debit or credit card?

 Students need either a credit card or debit card to order a parking permit. At this point, there is no other option.

10. May a student order a parking permit and be billed later?

No. Currently the student needs to pay for the permit at the time of ordering, with a credit or debit card.

At Evergreen Valley College, the police department is located across from Admissions & Records. At San Jose City College the police department is located in the Student Center, Room SC-108.
